Education Impact

Over 540 hours of group lessons delivered, covering:

- English language learning.
- School support in Portuguese & Maths
- Pedro II entrance exam preparation.
- University entrance exam preparation (ENEM).

Camps & Activities

Our Summer and Winter Camps host over 20 kids per session, offering 20 days of activities that foster teamwork, creativity, and outdoor learning.





Language Exchange

International students joined pizza nights and volleyball games, promoting cultural connections and language immersion.



Community & Celebrations

Our last End-of-Year Party was a celebration recognizing student achievements and the dedication of our community. We celebrated with awards, prizes, and food baskets to ensure our students had a joyful and well-supported holiday season.

Internships & Career Development

- 1 student gained professional experience at Caminhos. Tyson is preparing to be a tour guide through his internship at Caminhos.
- 2 students completed a 15-day internship at EcoCaminhos, acquiring hands-on skills in sustainable practices. (Tiago and Tyson).

Mais Caminhos remains committed to expanding its impact, strengthening partnerships, and innovating educational approaches.

In 2025, we aim to:

- Increase student enrollment to 60 while improving retention rates.
- Enhance our educational support, providing more resources for students preparing for university and vocational paths.
- Develop new partnerships to create further internship and mentorship opportunities.
